

Frequently Asked Questions

What can I do to try and find supporters?

One way to raise supporters in 30 for 30 is simply becoming educated on the history of SunErgos International and the work we are doing with orphans and street kids. This way your family and friends will get a good idea about the organization you are raising funds for. Visit our website for more information: www.SunErgosInt.org. Use social networking as a way to ask for support. Make sure to include what the event is about, why their support is important to you, what days and time 30 for 30 is happening and how much each hour cost. You can find an example letter with this information on our website, under *30 for 30* link.

Can a sponsor cover more than 1 hour?

Definitely. A sponsor can cover as many hours as he or she would like.

What if a sponsor cannot donate \$30?

We understand that, for some, \$30 may be too much. We invite you to donate what you can and join us in praying and fasting. God can do incredible things with even the smallest amount.

What if I want to cover an hour in 30 for 30 but don't have a specific person to sponsor?

Some of you will discover this event through our website, Facebook, Twitter etc. and not be connected with a specific person to sponsor an hour from. We encourage you to take on being a faster and try to find friends and family to support you through the 30 hours. We also recognize that some of our fasters may not be able to find sponsors for all 30 hours. If you are looking to just donate an hour of funds and prayer, you can donate on our website to 30 for 30. Please make sure to still set aside an hour between May 4th at 9:00AM and May 5th at 3:00PM to pray for Russia's orphans. A prayer list is provided on our website at sunergosint.org.

If I was unable to attend the informational meeting, where can I pick up the information I need to participate?

At our meeting we will be handing out starter packets to everyone who would like to participate. These included multiple brochures, prayer cards, and sponsor cards you can distribute to each person covering one of your 30 hours. If you missed the meeting but still need a starter packet there are a few ways you can receive one. Can I get a receipt for my donations?

SunErgos International is a U.S. non-profit, public charity approved by the IRS as a tax-exempt, 501(c)(3) charitable corporation. Donations can be made payable to SunErgos International and you will be provided with tax-deductible receipts. IRS requires non-profits to provide a receipt for yearly donations over \$75. To save administrative costs, we only provide a yearly receipt and for donations totaling over \$75. If you need a receipt sooner and/or for a donation under \$75, please contact us.
